In pursuance of our earlier order, Ms.Geetika Sharma, Joint Director, Department of Women and Child Development, Mr.A.K. Saxena, Executive Engineer, (Construction), Public Works Department, Mr.Y.P. Gupta, Assistant Engineer, (Construction and Maintenance), Public Works Department and Mr.S.C. Vats, Assistant Prohibition Propaganda Officer, Department of Women and Child Development are present

Dr.Rajesh Kumar, Executive Director, SPYM with whom the Department of Women and Child Development is going to sign the MoU is also present. We must fairly state that Ms.Geetika Sharma, Joint Director submitted that the work order has been issued for total renovation of the de-addiction centre at Kingsway Camp situate at Sewa Kutir and that would take time but it can be made acceptably functional immediately. We have been apprised by her as well as by Dr.Rajesh Kumar that to make it functional for the present, two gates are required to be fixed so that the ingress and the outgress is controlled. It is also agreed that there should be two temporary toilets as more children are to be admitted for treatment at the centre. It is suggested that mosquito nets along with proper beds are to be provided. The building from outside is required to be painted. Needless to say, as Mr.S.C. Vats would submit that painting would make it environmental friendly.

In view of the aforesaid, it is directed that two temporary toilets, the two gates and the outside painting should be completed by 15th April, 2011. 20 mosquito nets along with other ancillaries shall be provided within three days.

Ms.Jayshree Satpute, learned counsel, who has been assisting this Court, has assured that she will go intermittently to see the work but not interfere. She shall file her report when the matter is called next with regard to the progress of the work.

At this juncture, a submission is made by Ms.Satpute that vocational training should be provided at the de-addiction centre. We must appreciably state that Ms.Geetika Sharma, Joint Director immediately responded that the vocational trainers shall be engaged at the centre to impart vocational training in at least 4 to 5 vocations to the children, who are in conflict with law and suffer from addiction. Be it noted, this is imperative for such children as a diversion of mind is necessary. We may hasten to clarify, the vocational training is necessary for all kinds of juveniles who are in conflict with law for the purpose of re-formation and rehabilitation but we have laid emphasis on this category of juveniles as that is the lis today. The Director, Department of Horticulture is commanded to see that the open area is properly taken care of and made green, making it environmental friendly which has soothing effect and works as an antidote. Ms.Neha Kapoor, learned counsel assisting Mr.N. Waziri, has undertaken that she would intimate the Director, Horticulture to start the work from tomorrow

Let the matter be listed on 6th April, 2011 so that the progress can be apprised to this Court. The officers, except Ms.Geetika Sharma, Joint Director, as she has been granted child care leave, who are present today, shall remain personally present on that date to assist the Court. We have also been apprised at the Bar that a similar issue is pending consideration in WP (C) No. 12462/2005. WP (C) No. 12462/2005 will be listed along with this writ petition on 6th April, 2011.
