Today i.e. 29.06.2019 at about 3:00 to 5:00 P.M., H.R.L.N. held a programme for womens at Jhabri Basti, Sonari, Jamshedpur and given information regarding the District Meeting on Human Rights and Laws related to women Laws.

Inauguration ceremony was host by Miss Jyoti Kumari, Advocate and below mentioned invited Advocates/Guests were present and stated regarding the Women Laws to the womens who were present in the meeting. ~~during the period 3:00 P.M. to 5:00 P.M.~~

- (1) Mrs. Sukanti Hembran stated regarding Child Marriage Act- She stated that the marriage age of an adult Indian (male 21 years and 18 years (for female) and below the age is prohibited under the Child Marriage Act.
- (2) Special Marriage Act - She stated that under the Special Marriage Act, the marriage is to be registered for the bridegroom and bride.
- (3) Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 - She stated that any women if tortured by her in-laws in Matrimonial house for the sake of dowry, then she may take shelter of concerned Police Station or to the competent court of law.
- (4) Indian Divorce Act 1969 - she stated that if any women tortured mentally or physically by her husband, she may instituted Divorce case/ against her husband in the Family Court.

- 5) Maternity Benefit Act, 1961 - Any pregnant women is entitled to get leave under the maternity Benefit Act, 1961 if she is doing service.
- 6) Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971 - If women is terminated from her services then she may take the legal recourse under that law.
- 7) Sexual Harassment of Womens at Work Place-2013 - She further stated that working women if misbehaved, teased by any colleague, then under that section she take the necessary action.
- 8) Equal Remuneration Act, 1976.- She stated that under that law every women (working lady) is entitled the get equal remuneration from her employer similar to the male employee



- (ii) Ms. Binita Mishra and Mr. Birendra Sharma - They stated regarding the Pocso Act, that if any minor female child is outraged by any person then he will be punish according to that section.

Maintenance Act - They further stated that every women,

either mother or wife is entitled to get maintenance.



(iii) Mr. Dilip Mahato - He stated/answered the questions/queries of the womens present in the meeting for the period 4:15 P.M. to 4:45 P.M.

He further stated about the rights of women under the law.
